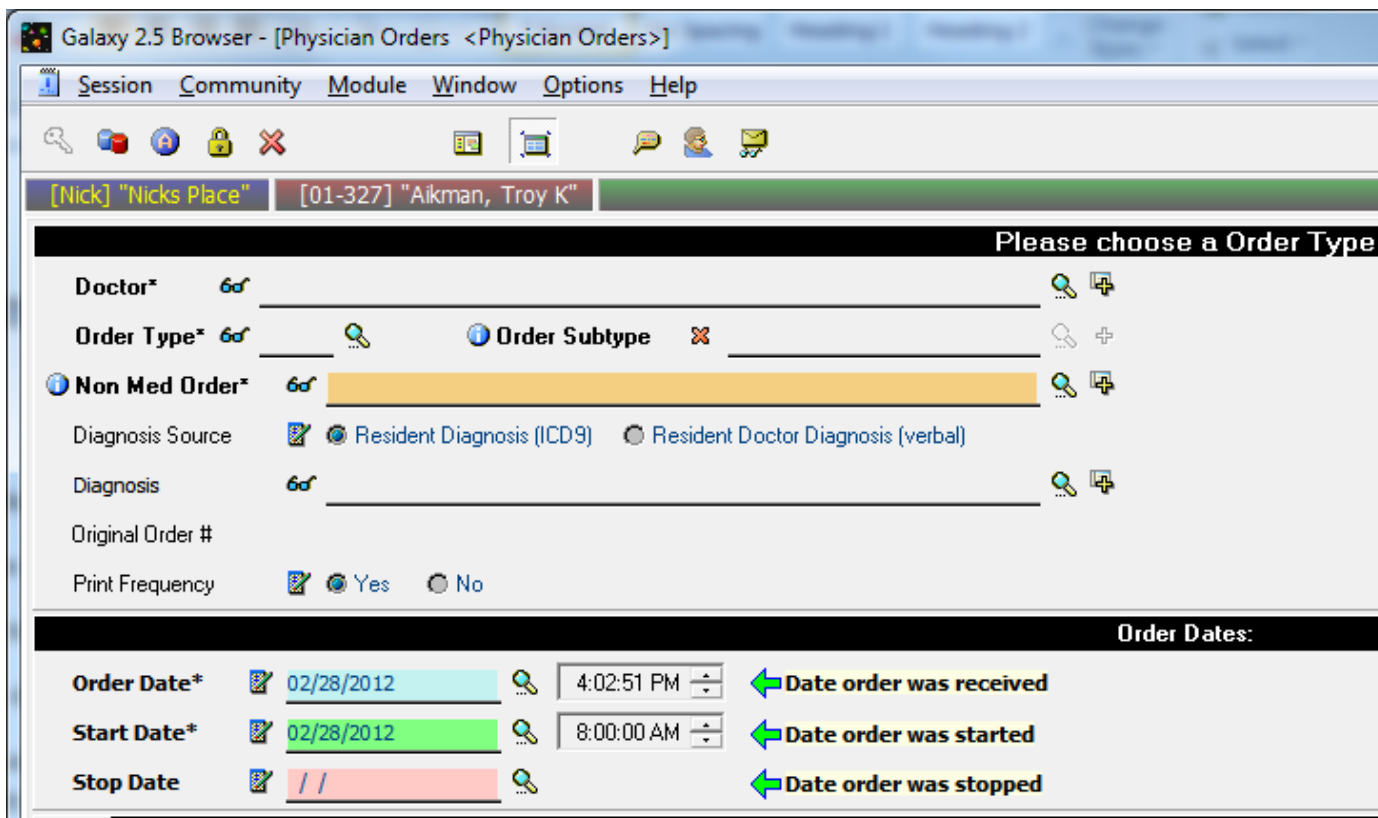
You will then choose your diagnosis source (ICD-9 or Verbal).



If you chose resident diagnosis you will pick from the list of ICD-9's that are associated with this resident (from ADT)



If you chose doctor diagnosis you will pick from the list of previously entered verbal doctor diagnosis that are stored in the Resident Diagnosis Draft table.



Print Frequency – this allows you to decide whether or not you wish the frequency to print on the reports

Order Date – Enter in the date and time (if applicable) that the actual order was received

This will default to current date and time

Start Date – enter in the date the order should begin as well as the time if a specific time is designated

- The system will use this time for scheduling purposes if the order is set to X hours
- Time will default to whatever time is set in your PO module master

Cyclical



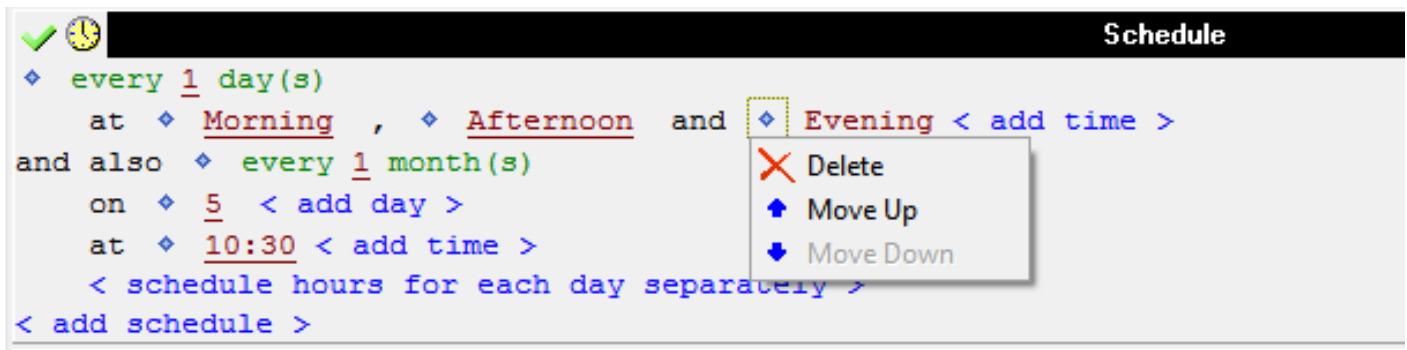
This allows you to enter in orders that have an on/off cycle

For example, you may have a Coumadin order that goes for 6 days and then off 2 when it's a different dose

You would simply enter two (2) cyclical orders

1. 6 days active at 10 mg, 2 days inactive
2. 2 days active at 2 mg, 6 days inactive.
 - a. Start date of second order is first day that the first order goes inactive

Now the program will schedule the correct dosage on the correct days and you have no more work to do



The blue diamond in front of the schedule choice allows you to delete the item or to re-order them

Click on the magnifying glass for Medication will bring you to the list of drugs.
